

Gale Kladitis, President

Gale has been a member of the Charles County Arts Council and Alliance since 1982. She has also been a member of the Board of Directors since 2007, Membership chair since 2008, and Gallery Chair since 2013. Gale was also Vice President from 2012 to 2017.



Robert K. Rausch, Vice President

Robert is the Founder of the Charles County Arts Alliance and has beem a member since its inception in 1987. He has Chaired or been a member of various committees during his 30 years of involvement. Robert was also Past President for a total of 11 years, and former Treasurer and President for a total of 16 years.

In Robert's own words,

"I am interested in serving on the Board of the CCAA as Vice President, to help further the development and expansion of the artistic organizations in Charles County, and to see an increasing recognition of those individuals who work in the arts either as amateurs or professionals. Ronald Brown, Secretary/Treasurer

Ron Brown was re-elected as Secretary/Treasurer. His background is largely in History, as evidenced by his Bachelor's degree in History from Frostburg State College, Master's degree in Nineteenth Century European History from the University of Maryland, and his full-time faculty position teaching History courses at Charles County Community College/College of Southern Maryland from 1970 to 2009. His movement to the Arts began gradually as the Chair of the Communication, Arts and Humanities Division from 2009-2014, where he administered faculty, programs and events in the visual and performing Arts, as well as courses in Art History, Communication, History, and Philosophy.

Since retiring in 2014, he has been voted to the CCAA Board of Directors, served on the Grants and Scholarship committees, and was appointed as Treasurer. Currently, he still continues in History as the President of the Historical Society of Charles County. He hopes to keep busy as Treasurer depositing membership dues, state and county grants money and writing checks to grant and scholarship recipients.

Diane Rausch, Past President

Diane is a native of Charles County where her family, the Berry family, has lived for over 300 years. She is a senior executive at NASA Headquarters in Washington, DC, where she currently serves as Director, Advisory Committee Management Division, in the Office of External Relations. She has been an active participant in the arts all her life, especially music, where she has performed with a variety of church, school, college and community instrumental and choral ensembles. She plays bassoon and clarinet, and sings alto. She and her husband Robert are the co-founders of three nonprofit arts and humanities organizations in Charles County: the Southern Maryland Concert Band (1984), the Charles County Arts Alliance (1987) and the Friends of Old Waldorf School Foundation (1994). Diane has previously served as president of the SMCB (7 years), and president of FOWS (5 years). Diane

has an M.A. in Political Science/International Relations from East Carolina University, a B.A. in Foreign Affairs from University of Virginia, and graduated from Thomas Stone High School in Waldorf. She and Bob enjoy attending performing arts events, galleries and historic sites in and around Southern Maryland, Chesapeake Bay living and boating at their condo at Solomons Island and foreign travel.



William (Bill) Adams, Director

Bill has served on the Board now for several years. He feels he brings a musician's point of view as well as a producer-of-events point of view. Bill has played music all his life and produced many musical productions. He feels his biggest contributions have and will continue to be serving strongly on the ArtsFest Committee. This is the biggest and most important event that the CCAA does because it promotes the organization countywide with a wide brush and a big splash. In addition to being a musician, Bill is an Athletic Director.



Joseph Wimberly, Director

Joseph Wimberly is an Online Marketing Solutionist who works together with business owners, entrepreneurs and creatives to help them start up and grow their online impact.
