On Thursday, August 9, with the help of 19 volunteers, the Arts Alliance created 500 Back-to-School art boxes to deliver to the Children's Aid Society. The boxes contain safety scissors, #2 pencils, colored pencils, crayons, glue bottle, glue sticks, and erasers, and will be combined with backpacks and distributed to children in kindergarten through 3rd grades.

Grant Application Deadlines: Community Arts Development - October 1, 2018 Arts in Education - October 31, 2018

Over the past 31 years, the Charles County Arts Alliance has awarded more than \$750,000 in grant funding to non-profit organizations and schools in Charles County to support activities in the performing, visual and literary arts. Last year, the Arts Alliance provided nearly \$49,000 in funding to 20 nonprofit organizations and schools. This has helped enhance our county's arts and culture, and inspire our fellow residents to explore the diverse arts community and arts offerings present in our own backyard.


As in previous years, our CCAA Arts Grant Program offers two types of grants: Community Arts Development (CAD) grants for nonprofit organizations, and Arts in Education (AIE) grants for schools. Schools may request up to \$500, while nonprofit organizations may be eligible for grants up to \$7,000.


Show Runs Through December 28, 2018

Those who attended the Photography I and II classes held on July 31 and August 14, and again on August 23 and 30, learned all they needed to know to capture, print and display their photos for judging at county fairs and submitting them for gallery shows. The classes as promoted in the Newsflash, were open to the public and, thanks to the generous offer from Bill and Suzanne Cassidy, were provided at no cost to the registrants.

Both Bill and Sue Cassidy are retired teachers (Bill as a second career after working for the government for thirty years), and both have a passion for photography, particularly nature photography. Bill has a degree in professional photography from Rochester Institute of Technology, making him the true photographer of the pair. Sue has been involved in picture-taking only since the digital revolution.

Both love to travel and to see beautiful places, and also love to capture the things they see in photographs. They have had two successful shows of their photos in a small gallery in Baltimore, and participated in many art and craft shows in Maryland, Virginia, and Georgia with their work.

When, after retirement, they decided to put their thousands of photos to some use, their daughter suggested they turn it into functional art--and their small business, Teachers With Cameras (visit <u>teacherswithcameras.com</u>), was born.
