Did you know in 1987: Aretha Franklin was the first female inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame, Vincent van Gogh's *Sunflowers* sold for \$39.9 US million (This sale made records for tripling the record for an auctioned painting.), and August Wilson won the Pulitzer Prize in drama for his play Fences? Did you know on September 17 the Charles County Arts Alliance turns 33?

Happy Birthday to us! The Arts Alliance was created "to stimulate, promote, encourage, and provide recognition of all the arts and the creative spirit in Charles County, Maryland." 33 years later this mission remains constant with over \$900,000 in grants awarded to schools and nonprofit organizations, thousands of dollars given to high school seniors toward their arts education, and multiple CCAA-sponsored free gallery spaces, showcasing the breadth of talented visual artists in the county. Even with the Covid-19 pandemic bringing the world to a standstill and new and milestone events being canceled, the Arts Alliance remained vigilant in moving to digital platforms.

Even amidst the many changes of 2020, the Arts Alliance will always "promote all the arts." Beginning September 1, the office has reopened, Tuesday – Friday, 9:00 am to 2:00 pm. Only one staff person is present per day and all visitors must make an appointment. The Board of Directors' upcoming retreat will finalize our fiscal year 2021 programmatic calendar. Members are encouraged to stay connected to the Arts Alliance's social media platforms for announcements and deadlines regarding virtual programs and the Community Arts Development grant program.

The Arts Alliance extends its gratitude to the Maryland State Arts Council, the Charles County Charitable Trust, and the Charles County Commissioners (Department of Recreation, Parks, and Tourism) for their financial support. We also appreciate our members who give their time and money to ensure the county is rich in all the arts: literary, visual, and performing. We look forward to continuing to provide opportunities for growth, enjoyment, and well-being through the arts in Charles County, virtually and in-person. *Source*

President's Letter

Dear Members and Friends,



Summer is nearly over and the fall will bring an unusual bunch of "new normals" to deal with due to the Covid-19 virus that still plagues our region and country. Even with the opening of Stage Three here in Maryland, we have a long way to go before our daily lives resume what they used to be.

The various changes in our Charles County Arts Alliance year include no P.D. Brown Gallery at the County Fair Grounds in September, extended display time frames for our current galleries, delay of our Community Arts Development (CAD) grant application due date until November, and no Gala at Old Waldorf School this year. The new programs include the preparation of 1,000 "art boxes" for needy students in partnership with the Board of Education, the continuation of Arts in Education (AIE) programs rescheduled from last spring, as well as new virtual AIE programming directed to all of our county schools, a special Charles County Children's Aid Society program scheduled for December, a Restart and Complete program for CAD and AIE programs that were canceled last spring and participation in Maryland State Art Council's Poetry Out Loud competition in the spring.

We have continued to increase our media presence on Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram, as well as expanding our YouTube presentations beyond our twice weekly Flashback Gallery Tours, to featuring our current scholarship recipients and creating a weekly musical presentation in partnership with the Charles County Youth Orchestra. Who knows what new opportunities await us in the "virtual world."

Our wish for all of you is that you, your family, and friends stay healthy and that we will be able to meet again at the ArtsFest in June of 2021. >




