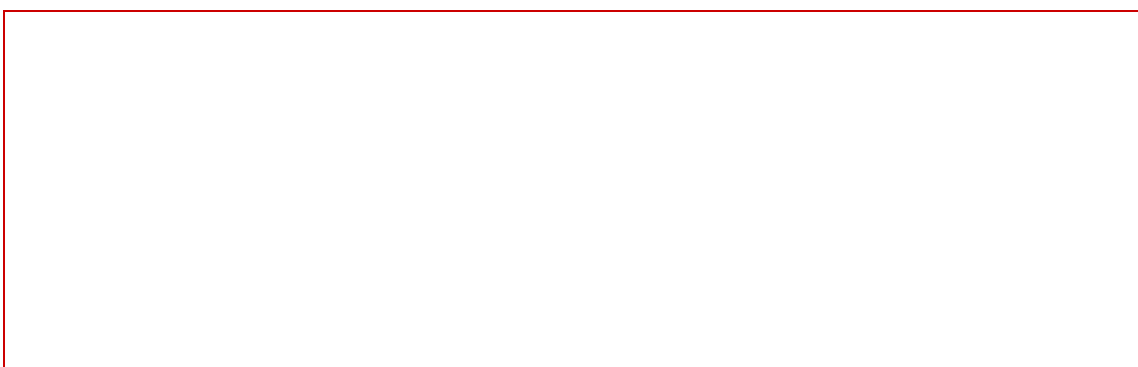

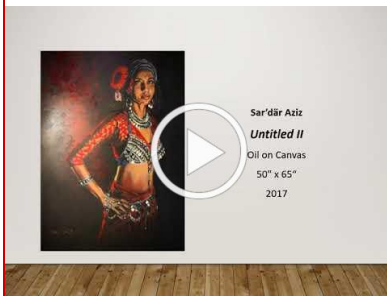
A Message from the College of Southern Maryland:

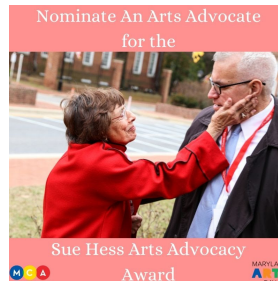
