

## Arts Teacher of the Year

The Arts Teacher of the Year award is a new CCAA program and honors an Elementary, Middle, and High School teacher in a creative discipline who exemplifies excellence in arts education. The program acknowledges Charles County's hardworking arts educators with the recognition and financial support they deserve, as they guide their students, despite continuing uncertain and stressful circumstances.

The award was created in collaboration with the Charles County Board of Education's Fine and Performing Arts Office in response to how COVID-19 has forever changed the creative community. Teachers, artists, and their industries have been greatly impacted – doors have closed on schools, libraries, galleries, and performance spaces around the world. The pressure to adapt has been felt by many, but none more acutely than arts educators. Each winner receives a total of \$1,000 to support themselves and their program.

Congratulations to the first-ever Charles County Arts Alliance's Arts Teacher of the Year winners: Christine Chinault – Malcolm Elementary School, Zoe Smith – Mattawoman Middle School, and Jana Heyl – McDonough High School. The winners will be acknowledged at this year's Annual Membership Meeting, Saturday, May 15, 2021. So
